2. This grant of approval is subject to the terms and conditions set out as follows:
 - a. The courses permitted by the Council for Private Education shall only be provided or delivered in Singapore.
 - b. Prior to offering the courses permitted by the Council overseas, TEG INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE is required to inform the Council in writing of its intention, and obtain the Council's approval to do so.
 - c. Where the Council's permission to conduct a course is subject to the continued approval or accreditation by the developer of the course, such permission may be withdrawn in the event the continued approval or accreditation has been withdrawn.
 - d. TEG INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE shall ensure that the teachers shall have the necessary and relevant qualifications and authority to use the title "Dr", and the rights and authority granted by universities or degree-awarding institutions recognized by the relevant authorities in the institutions' home country to use the title "Professor".
 - e. TEG INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE shall ensure that students who have signed up for the external degree programmes listed in Annex A herein, are formally enrolled or matriculated by the respective higher education institution(s) conferring the qualifications, within three months from the

commencement of their studies in the said programme(s) at TEG INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE.

3. Please note that under section 38(1) of the Act, the Council may suspend, or cancel the registration, or reduce the period of registration of a private education institution which has infringed the requirements of registration.
4. The Council acknowledges the notification of all the teachers submitted to teach the courses in this application.
